Qualifiers: Horse Leaders' Horse Show, Cass County Fair classes, Equine Test

Tie Breaker Classes: In the event of a tie, the winner will be the highest placing is Showmanship. If a tie still exists, Horsemanship will be the deciding factor.

Classes that have adult participants will still follow the above point system. (Example: if you place 3rd overall in the class with two adults ahead of you, you will still receive 4 points in a full class.)

Points from the **Equine Test** will be awarded on a pass/fail system. 6 points will be awarded for taking the test and passing it with at least 50% correct; 3 points will be awarded for taking the test but not passing. Date for taking the test will be determined when schools are out for summer break. The test will be given at the Cass County Fairgrounds, with the makeup test being the following Monday at the Cass Public Library.
